Inkle Looms Made Easy

Do you have an Inkle Loom sitting around and do not have a clue on how to thread it and weave on it? For the January guild meeting program I will discuss how these simple looms work and how to go about threading them up. Inkle looms produce a narrow band of weaving that can be used for straps, trim, and edges; the possibilities are seemingly endless. Inkle bands are very strong and lay flat. Do you have an Inkle loom collecting dust in a closet and would like to learn how to weave on it? Well, bring it along and I will help you start threading it up for weaving. See you there.
