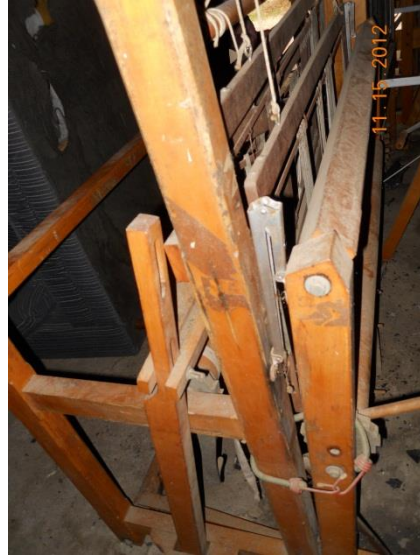


Counterbalance loom 40" weaving area \$300 obo *
