4 eggs

¾ cup sugar	½ cup flour
¼ cup butter	1 tsp. vanilla
1 cup coconut	Dash of salt

Combine all ingredients in a blender; turn to high speed and count to 10 slowly. Turn off blender; pour into well-greased 10" pie pan. Bake at 350 degrees for 40 minutes.


