

- IV. All entry items must be tagged with your name and the price or "NFS". Remember, each item has to have a title and medium used.
- V. Everyone mark your calendar for the evening of October 5 for our reception at Arts Visalia.
- VI. Let me know if you need me to send you the inventory sheet or agreement form again.
- VII. Call me if you have questions. This is going to be fun!
