Your Guild Library has added a new book:

***Huck Lace Weaving Patterns with Color and Weave Effects* by Tom Knisely.**

This book contains 144 patterns and 4 color themes for each pattern - that's 576 combinations. Each pattern in this book includes the full draft and a woven sample for reference. Tom also includes details for five projects that are perfect for weaving Huck: dish towels, mug rugs, baby blankets, and two scarves.

The book is an essential resource the weaver will turn to for inspiration and guidance again and again. It will be available for check-out at the November meeting.

For Sale: 24” Kromski Rigid Heddle Loom with stand and the following accessories:

- 2 12 dent reeds
- 1 Heddle Block (this allows the weaver to use the 2 12’s at the same time
- 1 8 dent reed
- 1 5 dent reed

Pick up stick, threading hook, pegs for converting the loom into a warping board, warping peg etc.
