Welcome to our annual Show and Sale. We hope you have fun participating in the show and connecting with the community with the folks who support us. This is our time to share the message of our fiber journey with others in the community and perhaps recruit a few new members.

Sale:

There are a few rules and regulations we'd like everyone to follow to guarantee we have the same high quality show our public has come to expect. The following rules were agreed upon for items in 2025.

Who May Participate As Sellers:

Members of HWOTV whose dues are paid in full by April 30th.

General Policy:

- All items brought in for sale must be new handwoven, handspun yarn, fleece, or felted. All handmade items
 must be made by the HWOTV guild member. Exception: You may sell used equipment, books, and excess
 yarn in your booth.
- Handwoven items must be at least 50% handwoven.
- In 2025, as approved by guild vote, hand-knit or crocheted items may be made using the member's handspun yarn or commercial yarn and noted on the item's tag. These items must be submitted to a 3 person jury between September 25, 2025 and October 24, 2025.
- Hand-felted items are accepted including needle felted, Nuno felted, and water bath felted items.
- Mill-spun yarn for sale made from members' flocks or farms is allowed as well as fleece, raw, or prepared into roving.
- Coiled or woven baskets are accepted. These can be coiled or woven on a wood or gourd base.
- Surface designs, printed, painted, or dyed on commercial fabrics, such as silk scarf blanks, are accepted, but are to be displayed clearly marked as not handwoven.
- All new products will be evaluated prior to Show and Sale to ensure that they are aligned with the guidelines.
 Please ask the chairperson about items not specifically listed above. Please submit your project for approval by the September meeting.
- All knitted and crocheted items made from commercial yarn will be juried by a jury of three.
- Show and Sale ends at 3:00 PM. Participants may not breakdown their booth before 3:00 PM.
- Community Table will allow each C. T. participant to show and sell a maximum of 2 items. C. T. participants will be expected to be present and act as their own banker.

Revised 2025, by vote

Set up for the show is Friday, October 24, 2025.

Guild members who have reserved a booth space are welcome to decorate their booths any way they wish. **Tables** should be covered.

You are welcome to share booths to split the cost, however careful consideration must be given to how much your booth can attractively hold without appearing crowded.

You will be your own banker.

Booth sizes will be approximately 10' \times 10'. Again, this year, we will try to offer the 12 \times 12 booth size (no promises). You may request a specific number of tables; we will do our best to accommodate your request.
